

- It attracts students from all over the world.




Sustainable city


- We went to the restaurant Kolga for breakfast.

- Sometimes we rented electric scooters







Barbecue night


- On Wednesday, we had a barbecue where we could make hot dogs with various sauces and fried onions.

Trip to the Cliffs


• On Saturday after breakfast, we took a bus to the Kullabergs Naturum cliffs.
